Students Feedback for Review of syllabus

Responses: 98

The responses received from the respondents are presented as follows:

- 44% of students concurred with the notion that the curriculum was challenging. Additionally, 46.93% of students noted that the majority of the syllabus was effectively covered by the teacher during class.
- Furthermore, 44.89% of students expressed agreement with the idea that the depth of the course content met the expected Course Outcomes (COs).
- The sequencing of syllabus units received approval from 43.87% of students, while 40.81% of students acknowledged that the syllabus contained essential technical skills for the industry.
- A total of 51.02% of students observed that recommended textbooks were readily available and aligned well with the syllabus.
- Notably, 76.9% of students found that laboratory experiments significantly improved their comprehension of concepts and facilitated the application of theory to practice (Experiential learning).
- Additionally, an impressive 82.3% of students strongly agreed that the syllabus kindled their interest in pursuing higher education (postgraduate or research) in the specific subject.

- **Teachers feedback on Current Syllabus**

The opinion of the faculty on current syllabus is taken from all faculty members. A structured questionnaire was given to them for the purpose of response.

The syllabus provide freedom to adopt new techniques/strategies of testing and assessment of students noted by 70% of teachers. Bout 60% of respondents said that books/journals prescribed by University relevant and updated to cover the entire syllabus while 65% said that the syllabus covers modern & advanced topics. 60% of teachers confired that the syllabus is designed I a way to improve Employability index while 70% said that the content is challenging to teach and 75% realized that the objectives of the syllabus are clearly indicated.

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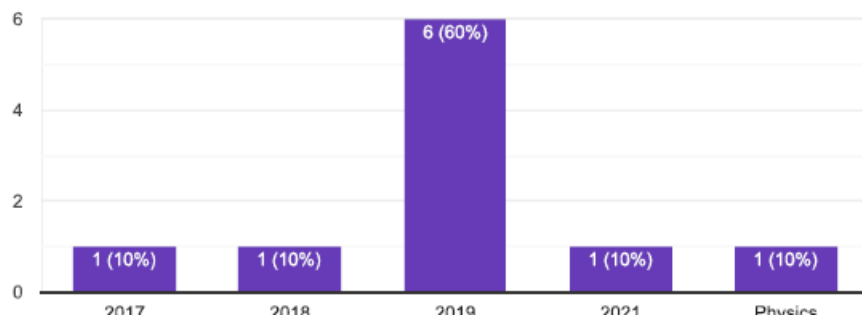

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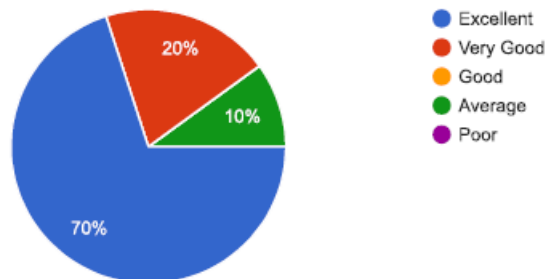
