About Department

The specialization includes Applied subjects like Marine Biology, Biotechnology, Bio-informatics, Hematology, Immunology, Toxicology and general Zoology. This syllabus helps Zoology students to get jobs in Hospitals (Paramedical, field Dialysis technicians, Dental technicians, and Pathology Lab) besides in Fishery industries, Clinical Research, Journalism, teaching, and business (in Shrimp, prawn , fish goat and ornamental culturing)

About Workshop:

The aim of this First Aid workshop is to protect a person before Medical help arrives. It refers to medical attention that is usually administered immediately after the injury occurs and at the location where it occurred. It often consists of a one-time, short-term treatment and requires little technology or training to administer. First aid can include cleaning minor cuts, scrapes, or scratches; treating a minor burn; applying bandages and dressings; the use of non-prescription medicine; draining blisters; removing debris from the eyes; massage; and drinking fluids to relieve heat stress.

This workshop will impart knowledge about steps to be taken during emergency related to health issues related to snake bite, burns, fainting, Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation, Bleeding, choking broken bones and conduct number of ambulance or hospitals.
